



Covid-19 Policies and Procedures

Procedures

- Temperatures of Coaches and Players will be taken prior to every session. Anyone with a Fever 100.4 will be asked to leave the premises.
- Screening Questions must be answered on a weekly basis.
- During Practices, Parents are asked to not enter the soccer fields and remain outside of the fences or in the Parking Lot. This is an effort to reduce the amount of people in one area. If it is a scrimmage, Parents can enter the field, but must social Distance themselves from family to family.
- Face Masks are required upon entering/exiting the facilities, and when using the restrooms.
- Players should ensure that they wear clean clothes to every session and ensure that all their equipment is clean and sanitized before attending any practice sessions.
- Players should not be sharing personal equipment or water bottles. Please ensure that players have all required equipment and plenty of water for the sessions.
- Parents are encouraged not to leave the facility until their child has been screened.
- Players are asked not to take the field/facility until the previous team has vacated the facilities and the coaches/managers are ready for the screening process.
- We encourage that families screen players
- We discourage Carpooling to and from practices
- Parents that attend practices and enter the facilities will be required to be screened and wear face masks. If parents sit behind the fence at practice they will need to wear a mask until they are situated and socially distanced.

When not to Attend practice

- When a player is showing symptoms, or think they may have the virus, that player is recommend to go and get tested and follow Medical Guidance
- If a Player has any symptoms (Fever, Cough, Runny Nose, Shortness of Breath, loss of taste or smell, Etc.) then they should not attend practice and be symptom free for 72 hours or receive a negative test.
- Any player that has tested positive should not attend practice and should quarantine for 14 days and symptom free for 72 hours.
- When a player Tests positive for Covid-19, all-members on the team and families will be notified that a member of the team has been tested positive. (We will not disclose the Individuals name).
- Anyone that has been within 6 feet of someone who has Covid-19 for 10 minutes or more must quarantine themselves for 14 days or more. These time periods will not change with a negative test or a doctor's note.
