



RRGSA COVID-19 SAFETY PROCEDURES

FANS PLEASE SOCIAL DISTANCE & REMAIN 6 FT APART

REQUEST ONLY IMMEDIATE FAMILY ATTEND PRACTICES AND GAMES

MASKS ARE RECOMMENDED

- A waiver was signed for each player at registration. Review waiver for additional information.
- Hand sanitizer dispensers are installed outside the bathrooms and at the concession stands.
- Fans are encouraged to spread out throughout the facility and not congregate around the bleachers during practices and games.

GAMES:

- Coaches and umpires social distance in all scenarios possible.
- Lineup batters max of 3 players in dugout and outside down the fence line 6 ft apart.
- Social distance in huddles before games, between innings or after games.
- If changing catchers, equipment must be sanitized before switching to another player.
- No handshakes between coaches and umpires.
- No players high fiving or slapping hands after games.
- Players will line up on the foul line after the game and say good game to their opponent.
- If a player is injured, a coach will request the parent tend to the player if needed. A coach can tend to the player if authorized by the parent.
- Masks are recommended, but not required.
- Players recommended to bring hand sanitizer.

PRACTICES:

- No sharing equipment.
- Player bags hung on fence 6 ft apart and not in dugout.
- Coaches and players social distance in all scenarios possible.
- Coach equipment cleaned before and after practices.
- Keep drills to small groups and social distance when in lines for drills.
- Masks are recommended, but not required.
- Players recommended to bring hand sanitizer.

In the instance a **PLAYER** tests **POSITIVE** a member of the RRGSA board needs to be notified immediately. Each player on the team will have to be tested or wait 10 days before returning to practices or games. (If tested, documentation of the negative result will need to be provided to return to practices/games) If a team does not have enough players to field a game, will attempt to reschedule. In the event can't reschedule, the game will be dropped and will not count towards standings.

In the event **ANY MEMBER OF THE HOUSEHOLD** tests **POSITIVE** a member of the RRGSA board needs to be notified immediately. The board will discuss with the family and determine an appropriate course of action. A player will not be allowed at a practice or game until a plan is implemented. This will be on a case-by-case basis.

DISCLAIMER: Participants, parents, family, and spectators engaging in softball and activities related to softball do so with knowledge of the risk and potential exposure involved and agree to accept any and all inherent risks to their personal health.

As to all applicable persons, people should be instructed that if they are exhibiting symptoms of possible exposure to COVID-19, such as fever, that they should not come to events until such time as the participant has been tested and/or cleared.
