INTERLEAGUE RULES  
2021 SEASON

**SENIOR & JUNIOR GAMES WILL HAVE A 2 HOUR AND 15 MINUTE DROP DEAD FROM THE SCHEDULED START TIME.**

NO local league rules. Regular season green (blue) book rules only.

The **'Mercy Rule'** will apply as stated in the Little League rule book 4.10(e)

Bat the line- up, Continuous Batting Order (**CBO**), with free substitutions 4.04.

Mandatory play applies. 6 defensive outs and 1 at bat minimum. Regulation IV(i). Page 55

Official Scorebook will be at game site. The District 71 Pitch Log will be used by all teams.

The home team will provide 1 official scorekeeper and 1 pitch counter who will sit together close to home plate as designated by the host league.

Manager, or acting manager, must have the pitch log card with you prior to start of game or go get it.

Game will not be delayed for lack of pitching log. Manager leaves games site until he/she has current pitch log. Manager will not be replaced while gone.

If discovered later that pitcher was not eligible, forfeit + 2 game suspension for manager.

Both teams will help with the set-up and putting away of the equipment.

Each team will furnish 2 game balls. If you ask the host league for baseball's they will charge you \$5 per.

1 adult must always be in dug-out.

**Bats:** See rule 1.10.

**Junior Division:** USABat, BBCOR or Wood is allowed. Diameter not to exceed 2 5/8".

**Senior Division:** BBCOR or Wood only. Diameter not to exceed 2 5/8".

**Courtesy Runner;** Only allowed for the pitcher or catcher when there are 2 outs. **7.14(b)**

**Games may start with 8 players;** the 9<sup>th</sup> spot will be skipped. No out is allowed. **4.16**

**Sports Complex:** lock code - **2705**

**Red Hill 90':** If the Storage room or Scorekeepers Room is locked, see the snackbar people for help.

**REMINDERS:**

- Face coverings to be worn when not participating in the activity (e.g., on the sidelines/dugout).
- Face coverings to be worn by coaches, support staff and **observers** at all times, and in compliance with the CDPH [Guidance for the Use of Face Coverings](#).
- Observers maintain at least 6 feet from non-household members.

**Discipline:** Each league will be responsible to take action against players, staff and parents that act in a way not becoming to Little League. If the interleague committee (District 71 rep. and 1 rep. from each league) feels that the problem was not handled properly, it will take action to correct the situation. Remember that each Leagues Board must approve all managers / coaches for each season and All-Stars. So do not make the wrong impression now.
