

Clearview Youth Football and Cheerleading Covid-19 FAQs

What if an athlete or coach is showing symptoms of illness? (i.e. fever, cough, etc)

We ask that anybody (coach, athlete, volunteer, spectator, sibling) that is not feeling well to please stay home until they are no longer experiencing symptoms.

What if an athlete or coach tests positive for Covid-19?

According to the CDC guidelines for youth sports, If an athlete or coach tests positive for Covid-19, then the entire team must self quarantine for 14 days.

What if a parent/sibling/spouse/other person living in the same residence as the athlete or coach tests positive for Covid-19?

The athlete or coach and all household members would have to self quarantine for 14 days. According to the CDC guidelines for Community related exposure, any individual who has had close contact (less than six feet apart for more than fifteen minutes) with a person who has tested positive for Covid-19 must self quarantine for 14 days and self monitor symptoms. Return to practice or games can resume after a negative test result is presented to CYFC President or Safety Officer.

What if a parent/sibling/spouse/other person living in the same residence as the athlete or coach has been exposed to an individual who has tested positive for Covid-19?

We ask that the family member follow CDC guidelines to self quarantine and not attend our practices or games until that period is up, but as long as the athlete or coach closely monitors their own health and is symptom free, they are able to attend practices and games as usual.

What if an athlete or coach has traveled to a state that is on New Jersey's list of states on the travel advisory list?

The athlete or coach is expected to self quarantine for fourteen days, and as per Governor Murphy's guidance "The self-quarantine is voluntary, but compliance is expected." Please check the NJ Covid-19 website frequently for updates.

Failure to comply with CYFC's quarantine requirements will result in expulsion for the duration of the season. The child (athlete) will still be able to participate in games and/or practices, but those who violate our Covid policy (parent/guardian/family member/friend of athlete) will be unable to attend any further games or practices.
