RGBA FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE OVERVIEW

The goal of the RGBA is to enable all those who wish to participate, the ability to do so. Thus, the RGBA will consider providing financial assistance for all those who request such assistance. The RGBA will accept applications for financial assistance each year. The overall number of applicants for assistance, types of requests, and the amount of financial assistance provided will influence the total amount of assistance available each year. Assistance will be considered on a first-come, first-served basis.

Information is confidential and will generally not be shared with anyone outside of the Board sub-committee that reviews the application. In certain circumstances, some information might be shared with other members of the Board.

Guidelines are as follows:

- All players must have a minimum payment made at the time of registration.
- All players requesting financial assistance must have a financial assistance request form submitted.
- Unless otherwise stated, all applicants must also apply for the Richfield R.E.A.D.Y. program or submit a reason why an application for Richfield R.E.A.D.Y. will not be submitted (i.e. annual limit already reached for Richfield R.E.A.D.Y.).
- All players must be paid for in full by the deadline. The deadline will be provided at the time of application for financial assistance.
- Any other situations with unforeseen circumstances, not described above, will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
