RGBA Uniform Policy & Care Instructions

Procedure Approval Date: July 1st 2019

Policy Statement: *Participants enrolled in the traveling basketball program are required to wear RGBA-designated uniforms while competing and representing RGBA. All traveling players will be supplied with one uniform set (jersey and shorts) at the beginning of the season.*

Definitions: Upon issue, RGBA uniforms become the responsibility of the registered RGBA family for maintenance and care. In the event a uniform needs repair or replacement, RGBA participants will be required to return the uniform in exchange for a replacement. While normal wear and tear is expected, excessive damage or loss of RGBA uniforms may result in disciplinary action or fees.

Rationale: The presentation and care of RGBA uniforms are a reflection on the quality of the RGBA program. This policy describes RGBA's position to ensure RGBA participants who are engaged in basketball competitions are clearly identified as representing the RGBA community and programs, and at the highest level.

Procedures:

1. Each RGBA traveling program registrant will receive one uniform set during Uniform Distribution Day:
 - a. All RGBA players must pay a \$50 deposit (check preferred) in order to receive a uniform
 - b. All player's fees must be in a paid status or have a payment plan in place in order to receive a uniform.
2. RGBA participant guardians are required to sign the Uniform Policy and Care Guidelines for the uniforms
 - a. The uniforms are considered RGBA property and are to be returned immediately in the event of separation from the program, at the end of season collection session or anytime on demand. If all issued uniforms are not returned, RGBA will accept the uniform deposit as payment for the outstanding uniform.

Uniform Care:

1. Uniforms should be laundered after each use.
 - a. Machine Wash separately
 - b. Use cool water setting with mild detergent
 - c. Air dry
2. Stain Removal

-
- a. Use treatment solutions like OxiClean® or Shout®-treat immediately and then machine wash
 3. Rips and Tears should be reported immediately to Head Coach. Head Coach will make recommendations for repair or assist from the Equipment Coordinator.
 4. Prohibited Actions
 - a. DO NOT Bleach
 - b. DO NOT Dry Clean
 - c. DO NOT Iron
 5. All assigned uniforms should be turned in on the day of the team's final game to each respective coach.
