



PDA Florida Registration and Payment Policy

Effective June 1st, 2016

PDA Florida is non-profit organization. The Mission of PDA Florida is to promote the game of soccer by providing the highest possible level of technical and tactical training, skill development, competitive team play, and to provide highly skilled and capable players with an opportunity to further excel in the sport.

Registration. All players are required to register on-line at www.pdaflorida.org. Player's first and last name must be entered as it appears on their birth certificate. New registrants must provide proof of age such as Birth Certificate, Passport or official translated copy of the Foreign Birth Certificate (if born overseas).

Payments. We accept Visa, MasterCard and American Express. Payment plans are available.

Please note that if ANY of your billing information changes, or your Credit/Debit Card is lost, stolen or has been replaced while on active installment plan, you must notify us immediately. You will not be able to update your payment plan yourself.

Registration is not considered complete and player's passes will not be issued until payments are made.

We have a variety of payment plans available with up to 6 monthly installments. If paying in installments, payments must be made by the 1st of each month.

Failure to pay for will result in player pass being revoked and late fees accessed.
