### Petite Ligue de Baseball du Canada

**Position:** Umpire in Chief – Regional Tournament (referred to as UIC)

**Description:** The UIC is appointed by the Tournament Director and is usually a local umpire in a leadership position (often the host district UIC).

**Reporting:** The UIC reports to the Tournament Director

---

The UIC must possess character, good judgment, the ability to get along with youngsters as well as adults, and the desire to do the job well. The UIC will have experience umpiring at the Divisional level in Canada. Experience umpiring at any level Canadian Regional tournaments or of the Little League World Series is considered an asset. The UIC will have a strong knowledge of the rules and umpire mechanics / rotations

The UIC is responsible for:

- Work with the Tournament Director to select umpires to be assigned to the tournament
- Ensure that all preparations for the tournament are completed within LL Canada guidelines. Including but not limited to, uniform orders completed as per LL Canada standard, ensuring accommodation and transportation arrangements are made of out of town umpires, ensuring appropriate change facilities are available for umpires;
- Work with local officials, including but not limited to Tournament Director, visiting District Administrators, LL Canada staff, Umpire Evaluators, National Umpire Coordinator & Tournament umpires.
- Attend all games and ensure umpires are prepared and at the game site on time. Provide other supports to umpires as required
- Work with Tournament Director and Umpire Evaluator to offer recommendations for playoff game umpire assignments
- Optional – Participate as an umpire in tournament;
