

MYSA Build Out Line Rule U9 - U11



Build Out Line Rule

For U9/10 players the "Build Out Line" will be marked on the field equidistant from the top of the penalty box and the half way line. For U11, Players there will be no field markings, but the "Build Out Line" will be considered the bottom of the "Center Circle" with markers off the "Touchline" where a line would normally intersect the "Touchline". There are no "Build Out Line" rules in U12 and older.

The purpose of the "Build Out Line" is to promote playing form the back. To this end, when the Keeper has the ball in their hands or there is a "Goal Kick" opposing players must drop back behind the "Build Out Line". Once opposing players are behind the "Build Out Line" the Keeper has 6 seconds to play the ball (The 6 Second Rule). Once the ball is put in play opposing players may cross the "Build Out Line" and play the ball. Keepers do not have to wait until opposing players are beyond the "Build Out Line" before they put the ball in play. There is no "Punting" in U9-U11 MYSA sanctioned soccer.
