MISSISSIPPI RUSH ANNUAL CONTRACT BILLING AND PAYMENT POLICIES

1. All fees are non-refundable.
2. Monthly dues are due by the **5th of each month** - (Aug-Nov, Jan-Mar), or can be paid up front, early, etc. A monthly payment schedule will be sent out to each family when the team budget is finalized. It is imperative for everyone to pay **on time**. Team budgets are a “cash flow” based budget which means the payment schedule is based on anticipated timing of when payments are due. **Every** player must stay current **every** month. You must be current with your financial obligations in order to play and participate in training. **There is a “no pay no play” policy for the club, and the player’s pass will be pulled so that your player cannot participate in any tournaments with the team until fees are up to date. If you are having financial difficulties making payments, or need to split the payments into smaller payments, it is imperative you communicate this with your team treasurer, and they can work out a payment plan with the family in conjunction with the club.**

3. Commitment periods:

Playing for Rush is an ANNUAL COMMITMENT –from August through May of the following year. All membership fees and dues remain an obligation to the team should a player transfer, move, be removed or quit for any reason prior to the end of the annual commitment.

4. Should a player transfer, move, be removed or quit for any reason prior to the end of the soccer season on May 31, monthly dues and any other outstanding fees are considered an obligation to Mississippi Rush Soccer Club and due upon termination of participation.
5. **Each family is responsible for volunteering, as outlined in the Volunteer Program Guidelines.**
6. Any payment returned to Mississippi Rush Soccer Club for Non-Sufficient Funds will be subject to a \$25.00 additional handling charge.

VOLUNTEER PROGRAM GUIDELINES

Mississippi Rush and Jackson Futbol Club both rely on a strong support system of parent volunteers to help maintain the fields at the Jackson Futbol Club complex, to help with tournaments, and any other team or club activities. Volunteers are the life-blood of any team and the backbone of any organization.

Jackson Futbol Club and Mississippi Rush are both volunteer run organizations. The Jackson Futbol Club complex is a private complex with no city, county or state support, so therefore must be maintained by its volunteers. Without parental involvement, there would be no tournaments as tournaments at every level require the coordinated effort of many volunteers and are fundraisers for any organization. Therefore these tournaments help support the soccer programs offered for your children. Your role as a volunteer is vital to the team and will have a great impact on your child's athletic environment.

All MS Rush families (Jackson, Madison, Rankin and merged/older teams) are required to volunteer over the course of the year at any club-hosted soccer tournaments and at times when the fields need maintenance. Volunteering for a job is very simple!

For any of the club-hosted soccer tournaments (JFC/MS Rush Crossroads of the South, MS Rush Spring Classic and JFC Premier Cup) or events, managers will send out a list of volunteer opportunities to his/her team parents. Parents will be given a 48-hour window to choose the time or type of volunteer opportunity. Once the 48-hour window has passed, the manager will assign the remaining open volunteer slots to those that did not sign up.

Volunteers are required to work the entire scheduled sessions for which they signed up for. Example: if you have signed up for a 3-hour slot to collect the \$5 parking fee, you are responsible for being there during that entire time slot. If you are unable to fulfill your volunteer commitment, it is your responsibility to find someone to take over your position and fulfill your commitment. Failure to show up for an assignment for which you are committed will result in a monetary penalty of \$50.00 paid to the Mississippi Rush Soccer Club.

Every family on the team is required to volunteer for each tournament. If you know you will be out of town during a tournament, please coordinate with your manager to volunteer for something you can do ahead of time, electronically, etc. Each family will be expected to help out once in the fall and once in the spring. The minimum time commitment will be 3 hours per family over the course of a weekend.

In addition, parents will be expected to help out with field maintenance which will include picking up trash and lining fields during the year.

Team managers will keep up with volunteer obligations for the families on his/her team. Mississippi Rush Soccer Club and Jackson Futbol Club are thankful and appreciative of the support of our great families.
