



### **2019 Parent/Guardian Release**

1. I/we the parent/guardian of the below named candidate for a position in the M.O.T. Youth Football & Cheerleading League, hereby give approval for him/her to participate in any and all football/cheer activities.
2. I/we represent that to the best of our knowledge and belief, our son/daughter has no physical, medical, or mental disability or other limitation which would restrict his/her ability to fully participate in this activity as described and explained to us.
3. I/we agree to furnish a copy of my child's state issued birth certificate prior to participation in any scrimmage or contact event. In the event a birth certificate is not available I/we will provide a passport or state issued ID. If a challenge is presented, I/we will present an original birth certificate, when needed.
4. I/we agree to allow the M.O.T youth football and cheerleading league to release photographs of my/our child for publicity in newspapers, social media, and our website.
5. I/we agree that by signing this agreement, release the coaches, assistant coaches, volunteers, and board members of the M.O.T Youth football and cheerleading league from any claim of negligence by ourselves, our son/daughter, our heirs, executors and assigns, from any liability arising from claims for damages for injury to our son/daughter any claims for loss of or damage to his/her person or property which may arise out of his/her participation in the M.O.T Youth Football and Cheerleading league for the current season.
6. I/we are aware that football and cheerleading are activities in which the risk of injury is high. These activities in general involve the risk of serious injury, including paralysis, even death. By signing for the below candidate, we are acknowledging these risks and allowing participation.
7. I/we agree to furnish a statement of Physical Condition prior to the first scrimmage which is signed by a physician; which states that my/our child is physically fit to participate in contact sports. The statement must be dated after August 1, 2018 and furnished prior to the scrimmage or contact event.

### **2019 Parent/Player Code of Conduct**

1. I will not force my child to participate in sports.
2. I will remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for the youth, not adults.
3. I will inform the coach of any disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
4. I will learn the rules of the game and the policies of M.O.T Youth Football & Cheerleading including refraining from the use of alcohol and tobacco on M.O.T football and cheerleading property.
5. I, my children, and my guests will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any League Official, coach, player, or referee such as booing, taunting, using profane language or gestures, or any physical contact of the above.
6. All vehicles must be parked in the parking lot. Only head coaches and approved board members are permitted to park in designated grass areas. I will observe posted speed limits and safety rules for the complex.
7. No dogs or pets of any kind are allowed at the M.O.T Football fields and complex.
8. I will praise my child for competing fairly and promote the well being of all children directly involved in the sport while staying within designated areas for parent and spectator participation during the course of activities on the fields.
9. I will refrain from coaching my children and other players during the course of games and practices, unless I am one of the official coaches of the team.
10. Failure to comply with the above listed statements may result in suspension or other disciplinary actions as deemed appropriate by the MOTYFCL Executive Board.
