HOME FIELD

Kell High School Stadium for Varsity home games and Kell Practice field for MS home games.

ESTIMATED PLAYER PARTICIPATION FEES

TKA MS: \$695.00 (player packs are optional and may be purchased)

AES MS: \$755.00

TKA Varsity: \$725.00 per player (includes player pack – tee, shorts, socks)

AES Varsity: \$785.00 per player

Fees include \$200 non-refundable deposit. The entire participation fee is due even if a player does not participate in spring practices.

The following fees and forms are due at Assessment/Equipment Issue Days (make all checks payable to TKA Athletics):

Players will not be issued a game jersey until all the above fees and forms have been turned in. All uniforms and equipment are property of TKA Athletics. If a game jersey is lost or damaged due to negligence, a fee of \$75.00 will be charged for a replacement jersey. All fees and forms must be turned in by August 3, 2020. Players who have not registered online, paid registration fees or submitted all required forms by the first day of season practices will not be eligible to participate. Checks should be made payable to TKA Athletics with “MS or HS Football Fee” written in the memo line. Checks should be turned in to the TKA the team treasurers.

PARENT VOLUNTEERS

Both parents are required to volunteer during the season at home and away games. The Volunteer Coordinator will use Sign Up Genius and/or Team Snap to make sure all volunteer positions are filled. Parents will be assigned to work in the concession stand for games played at Kell High School Stadium. Volunteers will be required to sign-in at the gate and will receive free admission to the game. Volunteers working on the sideline will be required to wear a field bracelet to have access to the field. Parents are responsible for getting their own subs in the event they are unable to fulfill their volunteer responsibilities. The volunteer check will be cashed in the event of a “no show.”

FIELD MAINTENANCE

Volunteers will be needed for field maintenance prior to spring practices and the start of regular season practices through the end of the season. Field maintenance positions include mowing and lining the practice field at Legacy Church and lining the practice field at Kell High School. We will hire professionals to do the initial marking and lining of both fields. The varsity football program is responsible for the mowing and lining of the field at Legacy Church and the middle school football program is responsible for lining the practice field at Kell High School. This is a season-long volunteer position and volunteers will receive free admission to the home games and will not be required to volunteer on game day.

PREGAME MEALS

Buffaloes Café in Woodstock is an official sponsor of the TKA Knight's football program. They provide the varsity team pre-game meals before every home game with the expectation that players, coaches, cheer squads and fans will eat at Buffaloes after every home game.

BUS TRANSPORTATION

A bus may be rented to transport players and coach to away games. This is ONE WAY transport. Players and coaches will need to make transportation arrangements home from away games. Any changes to transportation will be communicated through Team Snap.
