



The King's Academy Knights HIGH SCHOOL Affidavit of Eligibility

A student must not have reached his/her 19th birthday prior to May 1st preceding his/her year of participation. Students have eight consecutive semesters or four consecutive years of eligibility from the date of entry into the 9th grade. This means that once a student designates that he/she is a high school student, his/her eligibility clock starts ticking.

Alternative Education Students (AES, those not attending TKA) must live at home and, if taking college courses, must also be dual enrolled in HOMESCHOOL studies. AES Seniors will be required to complete a Senior Exit Form, which serves as a binding contract that their participation with The King's Academy's athletic program has ended.

Players will be publicly recognized as seniors only once at a Knights' event and must not "walk" during Senior Recognition at games or banquets until they are graduating from high school.
