HIGH SCHOOL ELIGIBILITY POLICY

Participants and parents must acknowledge acceptance of our Statement of Faith and Code of Conduct by signing the application forms included in the participant packet for each program.

A student must not have reached his/her 19th birthday prior to May 1st preceding their year of participation. Students have eight consecutive semesters or four consecutive years of eligibility from the date of entry into the 9th grade. This means that once a student designates that he/she is a high school student, his/her eligibility clock starts ticking. (NOTE: Eighth grade students not attending TKA may take high school level courses and not be considered a 9th grade student.)

Students not attending The King's Academy must live at home and, if taking college courses, must also be dual enrolled in HOMESCHOOL studies.

Players will be publicly recognized as seniors only once at a Knights' event, and must not "walk" during Senior Recognition at games or banquets until they are actually graduating from high school.

Seniors are required to complete an Exit Agreement Form, which serves as a binding contract that their participation with The King's Academy Athletic program has ended.

We acknowledge that we have read The King's Academy Athletic Eligibility Policy and agree to abide by these guidelines.

We understand that according to this policy, the above-named student's eligibility to participate in this Athletic program will end once this season is completed.
