

Good Morning U5 & U6 Rec Families

After careful consideration of current local and national guidelines to reduce the spread of COVID19, NRU has decided that we do not expect to be able to host our Recreational Program due to the Governor's order to stay at home through early June. This decision was not made lightly but due to an absence of available facilities and concern for the safety and well-being of our Members we will begin to process registration cancellations for the U5 and U6 2020 Spring Rec season. As a registered member of this league we would like to provide you with three options to invest your initial fee of \$60.

Option 1 "Donate to NRU": If you are able to make a tax-deductible donation of your registration fee to NRU, we will ensure that these funds are used to support the recovery and growth of NRU in the coming year. As you can imagine, these economic times have placed a financial burden on our Club that was not anticipated. While we have prepared for some contingencies, the ongoing support of our Membership through charitable contributions will be a key in our ability to provide future programming. Thank you for considering this option.

Option 2 "Transfer": If you plan to participate in our next available Recreational season, we would be happy to carry over the \$60 as credit to your next registration.

Option 3 "Refund": In these challenging economic times we are looking for ways to refund unused payments to our members. In the case of the U5 and U6 Recreational Program we are able to refund you \$60 from your original payment. (Note: NRU has determined that there were no non-refundable administrative fees at this level of programming.) If a refund is requested, we will be issuing the funds in the next couple weeks.

In order to proceed we ask that you complete [this U5 and U6 survey](#) to notify us of your cancellation selection no later than April 17th.

We are all disappointed that we will not be able to hold our 2020 Spring Recreational season, but we are thankful for the health and safety of our membership. We look forward to seeing you on the pitch in the near future!

We will inform you of potential programs we plan to offer once these stringent but necessary safety policies are alleviated. We know and believe the future will be a bright one and thank you as always for your patience, love, and support for the club as we have worked through this process!
