

## **FAQ's**

### **Can I have a co-ed team?**

Yes! Co-Ed teams must play in the boys division however.

### **Can I enter a U9, U11 or U13 team?**

Yes! However, they will need to enter the next highest division – U10, U12 or U14 respectively.

### **Will there be separate Competitive and Recreational Divisions?**

Our goal is to have separate Competitive and Recreation Brackets within the age division. This will depend on the number of teams that register so we do not guarantee separate brackets.

### **What is the minimum age requirement for a U10 team?**

We don't have a set minimum age. So long as there is no safety issue posed by a younger player, they may play. Referees will make this determination if a player is under 8 years of age.

### **What is the cut-off date for the age divisions?**

We will be using birth year as our cut-off this year

U10 – Born in 2010 or later

U12 – Born in 2008 or later

U14 – Born in 2006 or later

### **Where do I send Registration information and what is required to be sent?**

You must include the application form and payment with your registration. We also strongly encourage you to send a copy of your roster to help speed-up the registration process on tournament day. You may make changes to your roster after submittal, but you will need to bring any changes with you on tournament day. Send these documents to:

### **What documents should I bring on game day?**

We will need a copy of your final (typed) roster (even if submitted earlier), proof of age for all players, and waivers for all players. We will keep the roster. You will keep the proof of age documents.

### **What information should be included in the roster?**

Most rosters from sanctioned soccer organizations will contain all the needed information. If you do not have one, the attached example may be helpful.

### **What qualifies for proof of age for players?**

A valid player pass from a sanctioned soccer organization (CPYSL, FCYSL, AYSO, etc) will be adequate. If a player pass is not available we will need a copy of their birth certificate or passport.

### **What information should my team parents/spectators know about?**

- All games are held at the complex (no off-site games so you can walk from game to game).
- We will have a full concession stand available (hot/cold food, drinks, etc). You may also bring food and drinks but grills are not permitted.
- We are a tobacco free complex (no smoking, chewing tobacco, snuff, etc). We also do not allow pets anywhere on the complex.
- Coaches and players of both teams will be on one side of the field. Parents and other spectators will be on the other side. Coaches and spectators are not permitted to coach from the spectator side of the field. No one is permitted to stand behind the goal area.
- Most importantly, while we want a competitive tournament, please make sure your parents/guests know this is supposed to be enjoyable for the kids. Encouraging words and sportsmanlike behavior by the parents/guests sends the right message to the kids. Be the example we want our kids to follow.
