This event is designed for AYSO Soccer Referees looking to improve their game. The objectives of the event are to:

WHO IS ELIGIBLE? This program is open to referee teams from the Regional to Advanced levels. Get two referee friends and sign up. Teams can have a mix of any level of referee between Regional to Advanced.

We are limiting the number of referee teams so enter early.

HOW IT WORKS: Each team will officiate (3) matches in U12 and U14 boys or girls games (2 Saturday and 1 Sunday AM). National Assessors and Referee Assessors will evaluate and score your performance as well as provide feedback after the match has concluded. Each referee will be required to center at least one of the assigned games.
