6 and Under Rules for Spring 2019

1. The Home and Away teams are determined by the schedule. The Away team will be first to bat, and the Home team will be first to field.
2. At the Head Coach's discretion, the team may hit the ball out of the coach's hand starting the first game. Each child will be given five pitches before hitting off the tee. Foul balls are considered one of the five pitches.
3. Teams will bat their entire lineup each inning.
4. All players will wear their own helmet when at bat, on deck or running the bases
5. Outs will not be counted but starting the third week of games a child put out will return to the bench.
6. Teams are expected to play every game. If games are cancelled for any reason, the teams will be informed via One Call Now. Any missed games will be rescheduled for a later day. If a manager is unable to field their team for a game, it is their responsibility to inform the other team and attempt to schedule a makeup game.
7. All games will be three innings or one hour and thirty minutes whichever comes first. Please strive to turn over the half-inning within a minute.
8. All children must play unless injured. Refusal to cooperate may present a danger to themselves or others.
9. All players must rotate positions every inning when fielding. No child should play the same position more than one inning in a game. There are no "specialists" in T-Ball. Players should be exposed to multiple positions.
10. The ball may be pitched underhand or overhand.
11. No adult without a background check is permitted on the field or dugouts.
