

MATCH DAY PROCEDURES DURING COVID-19



THESE TRAVEL PROGRAM MATCH DAY PROCEDURES APPLY TO ALL STAFFORD COUNTY USED FACILITIES

- **All Spectators, Players, Coaches / Staff and Officials** must perform a temperature check and conduct a health screening prior to attending any Stafford Soccer related event or activity. The temperature check and health screening can be performed by parents of minors, and may be reinforced by a coach or staff member if symptoms are recognized
 - **Temperature check** = anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or greater is prohibited from attending any event.
 - **Health Screening** = the following questions should be asked by a parent of a minor prior to attending any event:
 - Is your current temperature 100.4F or greater?
 - Have you been diagnosed with COVID-19 within the last fourteen (14) days?
 - Have you exhibited any symptoms of COVID19 in the last fourteen (14) days?
 - Have you been in close contact (within 6 feet for at least 15 minutes) of anyone that has been diagnosed with, or has symptoms of, COVID-19 in the last fourteen (14) days?

If the answer to any of the above questions is YES, you are not allowed to attend the Stafford Soccer event or activity, and must follow the [BACK TO PLAY](#) guidelines.
- **FACILITIES**
 - NO BENCHES OR TENTS PERMITTED
 - Club to provide site map indicating spectator and technical areas
 - Cones for player equipment and subs on bench to be laid out by Coach
- **SPECTATORS**
 - Wear face coverings to and from fields, and during game on the sideline
 - Social distancing (10 feet) from those not in “family grouping”
 - Must be behind net/fence, if applicable, and at least 10 feet from any sideline
 - DO NOT enter fields until 5 minutes prior to scheduled game time
 - Sanitize hands prior to departing your car
 - Exit facility / field as soon as possible upon completion of the game
- **PLAYERS**
 - Wear face coverings to and from fields, and keep on unless actively warming up for a match, or playing in the game
 - DO NOT enter field until 30 minutes prior to scheduled game time
 - Sanitize hands prior to departing your car
 - Upon arrival, go to designated Technical Area
 - Place bag/equipment in designated spot upon arrival at field (10 ft apart)
 - DO NOT share water, food, clothing or personal gear
 - Respect and practice social distancing when not actively warming up, or playing in the game
 - No high fives, hugs, or hand shakes
 - Clean up your area before leaving field, and dispose of all waste
 - Exit facility / field as soon as possible upon completion of the game

➤ COACH/STAFF

- Wear face coverings to and from fields, and during game
- DO NOT enter field until 45 minutes prior to scheduled game time
- Sanitize hands prior to departing your car
- Upon arrival, go to designated Technical Area
- Setup cones for warm-up area
- Sanitize equipment before and after the match
- DO NOT share water or food
- Respect and practice social distancing when on sideline
- No high fives, hugs, or hand shakes
- Ensure technical area is cleaned up prior to next team coming in
- No post game commentary – save for next practice session
- Exit facility / field as soon as possible upon completion of the game

➤ OFFICIALS

- Wear face coverings to and from fields, and keep on unless actively warming up or officiating the game
- DO NOT enter field until 30 minutes prior to scheduled game time
- Sanitize hands prior to departing your car
- Upon arrival, go to designated Official Area
- No high fives, hugs, or hand shakes
- Sanitize hands before and after the match
- DO NOT share water or food
- Respect and practice social distancing when on sideline
- Exit facility / field as soon as possible upon completion of the game(s)
