



Return to Play Guidance for Teams & Spectators

Youth Basketball League Play at
Lexington Leisure Center, Tri-City Leisure Center, Barr Road Gym, Batesburg-
Leesville Leisure Center and Gilbert-Summit Gym
Effective November 4th, 2020

Personal Protective Equipment

- ◆ **Face masks/coverings are required for entry at Lexington County Recreation facilities.**
- ◆ Spectators must wear face coverings at all times when feasible.
- ◆ Coaches are required to wear face coverings when feasible.
- ◆ Officials are encouraged to wear face coverings between games. When possible, Umpires/Officials should maintain physical distance and limit one coach from each team to attend pre-game meetings.
- ◆ Officials are encouraged to dress out prior to arrival.
- ◆ Officials are encouraged to bring their own personal water bottle.
- ◆ Spectators and players are encouraged to maintain 6ft of social distancing
- ◆ Teams and Spectators are encouraged to bring antibacterial wipes and hand sanitizer to use throughout the event.
- ◆ Commonly used areas and surfaces such as restrooms, doors, handrails, etc. will be disinfected regularly.

Facility Entrance & Exit Procedures

- ◆ Entrance and Exit pathways will be designated to encourage social distancing.
- ◆ Everyone is encouraged to use the designated entrance and exit locations to limit large gatherings of people.

Social Distancing for TEAMS

- ◆ Players are discouraged from sharing equipment, spitting, licking fingers, etc.
(NO Sunflower Seeds or Gum)
- ◆ Players should bring their own personal water bottle **(NO SHARING)**.
- ◆ Only players and coaches will be allowed in the bench area during warm-ups and games.
- ◆ Teams are encouraged to sanitize hard surfaces and high touch points when arriving for their first game and at the end of the game.
- ◆ Teams are encouraged to exit the facility as soon as the game is over. Do not congregate inside any open areas.
- ◆ **NO POST-GAME TEAM HANDSHAKES, FIST BUMPS, OR MEETINGS.**

Social Distancing for SPECTATORS

- ◆ Spectators are encouraged to bring personal chairs if bleacher seating is non-desirable.
- ◆ At completion of the game, spectators are encouraged to exit the complex immediately.
- ◆ When possible, spectators should follow 6ft social distancing.
- ◆ During practice times, there will be a limit of 1 spectator per child. Children belonging to the same household will not count as a spectator.
- ◆ During games, there will be a limit of 2 spectators per child. Children belonging to the same household will not count as a spectator.

- ◆ Players cannot be dropped off at the gyms with no form of transportation. Players are not allowed to stay at the gyms once their practice/games are finished.

Covid-19 Positive Test Procedure/Requirements

- ◆ Any player or coach who exhibits Covid-19 signs or symptoms must be Quarantine until cleared by a doctor. This would include a negative Covid-19 test.
- ◆ Any player or coach who test positive for Covid-19 will be required to Quarantine for 14 days or until they cleared by a doctor.
- ◆ Any team that has a player or Coach test positive for Covid-19 will be required to Quarantine for 14 days. This will mean no in person practices or gatherings for the team or group.
- ◆ Any player or coach that has a household member test positive for Covid-19, the player or coach will need to be Quarantine until cleared by a Doctor.
