

LEXINGTON COUNTY TENNIS COMPLEX

ADULT LEAGUE RULES

1. Captains are responsible for all league fees to Lexington County Tennis Complex.
2. The league fees **DO NOT** include practice times at LCTC.
3. CAPTAINS ONLY may call one (1) day in advance for two (2) practice courts.
4. For matches starting at **6:30** p.m., **captains must put players that are here on the court at the match start time. Players must be here ready to play at the scheduled match time or a forfeit will be enforced.** Players who do not go to the court for the start time will be warned by a LCTC employee.
5. If a later match cannot finish at 10 pm, the captain will be called the next day and given a warning. If this happens again, LCTC reserves the right to deny the team playing privileges at any Lexington County Recreation and Aging facility.
6. At 9:30 p.m. an announcement will be made on the intercom that **all lights will be turned off at 10:00 p.m. Matches scheduled for 7:30 or 8:00 p.m. must go to assigned courts and be ready to go on court as soon as possible.**
7. Each captain is responsible for “adult beverages” his/her team provides as well as ensuring that those “adult beverages” are in “**LCTC-approved containers**”. Players found having “adult beverages” in unapproved containers will be penalized. **Do not leave “adult beverages” on tables in the open; they must stay in coolers.**
8. Captains will be notified if their team has not complied with the “adult beverage” rule. **The team committing the offense will immediately lose the privilege of playing out of LCTC for the rest of the season and for one year thereafter.**
9. Each captain is responsible for registering his/her team with LCTC each season (Spring, Fall, Mixed and Combo).
10. Teams play out of LCTC on a first-come, first-served basis. There is a limit to the number of teams playing at LCTC each night.
11. **Waiting List. Teams on a waiting list to play out of LCTC will be placed on a first-come, first-serve basis. Placement of teams will be determined by the following:**
 - a. **The number of years a team has played, including practicing, out of LCTC**
 - b. **The number of years a team has played out of LCTC**
 - c. **Teams playing out of the Ball Park Rd. facility the previous year.**
 - d. **Teams that split into new teams**
 - e. **New teams**

All new teams will be put on a waiting list and placed as space becomes available.

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Waiver

By signing below, the Team Captain accepts the Adult League Rules and accepts responsibility for their team to comply. If a team member or Captain is found to be noncompliant, the consequences described in the Adult League Rules will apply. The idea of "LCTC approved beverage containers" has been explained to me and I fully understand and will comply.

LCTC Captains Responsibilities/ Adult League Rules/Waiver

Lexington County Tennis Complex reserves the right to make final decisions regarding teams playing out of this facility.

FREQUENT USER POLICY RE: TEAMS

A Frequent User is a person that has paid a lump sum, yearly fee to play at LCTC. As such the user does not pay per-hour court fees and is entitled to free court fees for one team per season (Spring, Mixed, Combo and Fall). In order to accommodate this perk, the court fee for each team will be reduced by the pro rata share owed by each Frequent User. Each captain must ensure that the Frequent User is not using the reduction on another team.

If you have Frequent Users on your team, you will pay the full amount of court fees at the time you secure your team's spot at LCTC. **Prior to the cut off date to register teams on TennisLink, you need to furnish a team roster to LCTC.** Once the new amount of court fees is determined, you will write a new check and swap it with the old one. There will be no further reduction in league fees if a team adds a Frequent User after the cut off date.

In order to figure your team's court fees divide the total team fee by the number of players on your team to determine each player's pro rata share. Take the pro rata share and multiply by the number of frequent users on your team. Reduce your check to LCTC by this amount. Below is an example.

\$200 court fees divided by 13 players equals \$15.38 per player.

2 frequent users times \$15.38 equals \$30.76.

\$200 minus \$30.76 equals \$169.24.

Check to LCTC will be \$169.24
