

Code of Conduct

Sheridan Community Recreation, Incorporated

1. Treat all players, officials, coaches, and fans with respect and courtesy.
2. Willfully abide by the rules of the game, and this code of conduct throughout all practices and games
3. The use of tobacco products or alcohol by players, coaches, or officials during games or practices is strictly prohibited.
4. The use of foul language by players, coaches, fans, parents, or officials will not be tolerated and is reason for immediate removal from the game or premises.
5. Excessive arguing with an official by a coach will not be allowed. No arguing with an official will be tolerated by a player, fan, or parent. Failure to abide by this rule after a warning has been given is justification for the coach, player, fan, or parent to be asked to leave the game, park, or gym.
6. A parent or fan may not verbally or physically abuse any player, coach, or official at any time. If such abuse occurs or continues after a warning, the parent or fan will be asked to leave the premises.
7. Unsportsmanlike conduct involving players or coaches will not be tolerated on the field or court. Any player or coach displaying unsportsmanlike conduct will be removed from the game.
8. Fighting and/or physical abuse is cause for automatic suspension from the league.
9. Upon a failure to abide by any of these guidelines, an incident report will be completed and filed with Sheridan Community Recreation, Incorporated.
