Expectations of Parents

1. Parents should work with coaches to make sure players are at practices and games on time.
2. During games, parents are encouraged to cheer for the team but should **not** be coaching from the sidelines.
3. Parents should be on the opposite side of the field from the players during games. Parents will not sit or stand on either goal ends of the field.
4. Mutual respect must be shown for the other team, coaches, and game officials. Abusive language or behavior will not be tolerated. Spectators are to show respect to one another.
5. Absolutely no sarcasm, harassment, or intimidation is allowed in any conversation with the referee.
6. Do not go on to the field at any time. The coaches and referee will handle the situation on the field, and if necessary, the parent will be called over by the coach when necessary.

LPSA Soccer Complex Rules and Requests:

1. No alcoholic beverages or tobacco products are allowed on the LPSA Soccer Complex. Please go to the gravel parking lot to smoke.
2. Please pick up trash after practices and games.
3. Vehicles are not allowed on the fields or sidelines. Please use appropriate parking areas. There are 3 parking areas to choose from: 1. Gravel parking lot next to the lake. 2. Gravel parking lot behind field 12 near the t-ball fields, and 3. Paved parking lot near the park and softball fields.
4. All dog waste must be disposed of properly.
