Payment Policy

FSK Jr. Eagles Basketball would like to provide all youth the opportunity to play recreation basketball, regardless of their economic background. Therefore, the following articles have been provided as guidance toward payments and open balances for basketball registration:

1. Players will remain on the waiting list until open balances are settled. Players that remain on the waiting list will not receive uniforms and may not participate in games.
2. Parents may request a payment plan, if they are unable to pay the full amount of the open balance at the start of the season. The payment plan must be submitted in writing using the FSK Payment Plan Form. The FSK Board must approve of all payment plans.
3. One-third of the registration fee must be paid in order for a player to receive a uniform and to participate in games. The full amount must be paid before the player may participate in the playoffs at the end of the season.
4. All outstanding balances from prior seasons must be settled before registration is accepted for the current season. Otherwise, the player will remain on the waiting list.
5. A hardship waiver may be requested, in the event that the parents are unable to afford the registration fees. A limited number of scholarships are available to be awarded each season. A hardship waiver can be requested by submitting a Payment Plan Form in writing to one of the FSK Board members. The FSK Board must approve of all scholarships.
