



OUT OF STATE PLAYERS 2020-2021 SEASONAL YEAR

NEW JERSEY RESIDENTS

New Jersey residents seeking participation with a member club in another US Youth Soccer State Association must obtain clearance and remit payment to NJ Youth Soccer. The following steps must be completed in order to obtain such clearance:

1. Register to the Out of State Players link with NJ Youth Soccer – [click here](#).
2. NJ Youth Soccer will review and approve the request if appropriate.
3. Once the request is approved, a signed Interstate Permission form can be found in the player's Sports Connect profile. This form must be submitted to the accepting state association for final approval
4. The accepting state association is responsible for generating a member pass.

Note: The player may not hold a primary membership with an NJYS member club while seeking approval for a membership in another USYS State Association.

NON-NEW JERSEY RESIDENTS

Non-New Jersey residents that are seeking a member pass to participate with an NJYS member club must receive approval from the state association in which they reside prior to receiving an NJYS member pass. The following steps must be completed to obtain approval for participation in NJ Youth Soccer:

1. Complete and submit the Interstate Permission form (page 2 of this document) to the home state association for signature and approval. The player is responsible for payment of applicable fees to the home state association.
2. Register directly with the NJ Youth Soccer member club through the applicable NJ Youth Soccer player registration process.
3. Upload the Interstate Permission form to the "Out of State Permission" document container in the player's Sports Connect profile. *Note: Players may also need to submit proof of age if they were not previously verified with NJYS.*
4. NJ Youth Soccer will review the Interstate Permission form and approve the player if appropriate.
5. Once approved by the state office, the NJYS member club will be able to print an NJYS member pass for the player. The player will be listed on the official team roster for NJ Youth Soccer.

Note: The player may not hold a primary membership with another state association while also holding membership with NJYS.



NJ YOUTH SOCCER INTERSTATE PERMISSION FORM

NON-NJ RESIDENTS ONLY



Per USYS Rule 201 "Player Registration," a youth player must register each seasonal year in the State Association where they reside with their parent/guardian. If the player is a student at boarding school or college in a different state, the player can register in the state their school is located. The player must receive permission from the state in which they reside, to participate with another state association. It is the responsibility of the player and parent or guardian to provide this completed form to the appropriate parties within both the releasing and accepting State Associations.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Player must register and pay any appropriate fee(s) to NJ Youth Soccer.
2. Access the completed and approved Interstate Permission Form in the player's NJ Youth Soccer account.
3. Submit the Interstate Permission to the Accepting State Association for approval.
4. Follow the applicable registration instructions and fee(s) with the Accepting State Association.

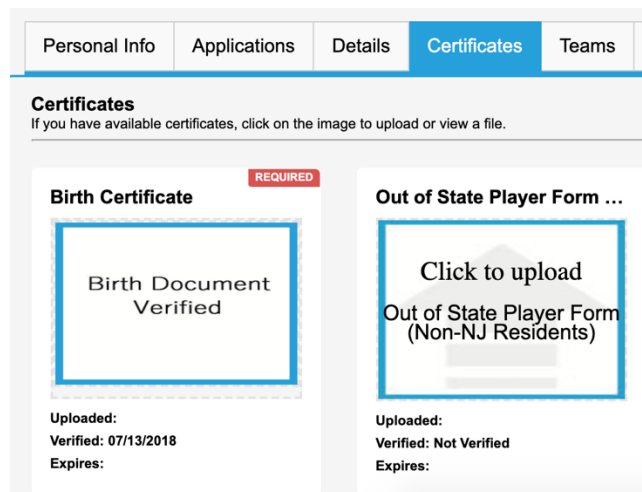

INSTRUCTIONS FOR UPLOADING PERMISSION FORM (NON-NJ RESIDENTS)

Once the player has obtained the signed Interstate Permission form from the home state association, the player must upload the document to their NJ Youth Soccer Sports Connect profile. To do so, follow the instructions below:

1. Register the player with the NJYS Member Club through Sports Connect.
2. Log-in to Sports Connect: njysa.sportsaffinity.com. *If this is your first time accessing the profile, click 'forgot password' to obtain a password reset.
3. Click on the player's portrait to view their information.
4. Click the 'certificates' tab select the "Out of State Player Form" box.
5. Chose a file to upload.
6. Once the file preview appears, click the green "Upload Image" button.



INSTRUCTIONS FOR ACCESSING THE SIGNED PERMISSION FORM (NJ RESIDENTS)

Once a player has received approval from NJYS to participate in another state association, the player should access the signed permission form in their Sports Connect profile. To do so, follow the directions below:

1. Log-in to Sports Connect: njysa.sportsaffinity.com. *If this is your first time accessing the profile, click 'forgot password' to obtain a password reset
2. Click the Portrait of the player.
3. Click "Print Documents".
4. In the pop-up window, find the Travel (2020-2021) seasonal year "Playing Out of State" application and click "Receipts and Forms."
5. Print the signed Out of State Permission form and submit it to the accepting state association.
