

GREEN HORNETS FOOTBALL: COST AND FUNDRAISING

Stinger Flag Football fees are \$100

Stinger Refunds: Roster positions, equipment and fees have to be secured following registration for planning purposes. As a result, refunds for stingers can only be given if the player drops prior to season start.

Tackle Registration fees are \$220 (about average for the cost when compared to all other AAYFA Organizations)

Please understand what you get with a Green Hornets' Football Registration:

- All Green Hornets' Football Coaches are certified under the USA Football Heads-up Certification Program.
- All Green Hornets' Football Coaches are certified on Concussion protocols.
- Green Hornets' Football teaches the USA Football Heads-up Football Tackling and Blocking techniques to include Seahawk rugby style tackling.
- All Green Hornets' Football Helmets are inspected, tested, cleaned and certified prior to each season.

Partially paid registrations (Full Scholarships are no longer available) are available on an extremely limited basis.
