IN MY WORDS AND ACTIONS, I PLEDGE TO:

- 1. Abide by the rules of the game,
- 2. Always give my best effort and work as hard for my teammates as I do for myself,
- 3. Be a good sport and acknowledge good plays whether they are made by my team or by my opponents,
- 4. Be a good sport and accept the mistakes that I make and those of my teammates, coaches and umpires,
