

LYSA Recreation Soccer Spectator Guidelines

- Familiarize yourself with the game and learn the rules.
Rules are posted on the LYSA website at www.lenoiryouthsoccer.org/recreation
- Please treat the coaches with respect and appreciation.
*REMEMBER: They are **volunteers** with varying levels of soccer & coaching experience and are doing their best to help your children learn the game.*
- Try to refrain from sideline coaching.
The kids get confused when the coach is telling them something and Mom or Dad tells them to do something else.
- Don't put undue stress on your children...remember they are kids.
- Encourage practice and work with them at home.
- Model good sportsmanship...your kids are watching your behavior.
- Please sit on the opposite side of the field from your child's team.
*Only coaches and volunteers who have been **approved by LYSA** are allowed to be on the benches and on the field with players during games and practices. Spectators are not allowed to sit or stand near the goals and goal lines during games.*
- Positive communication is encouraged from parents.
Leave the coaching comments for the coach to discuss with the children.
- **No Pets** allowed at the Rotary Soccer Complex per Lenoir Parks and Recreation rules
Pets are allowed along the Greenway
- **No Smoking/Vaping/Tobacco or Alcohol** products allowed
- Please park vehicles in parking spaces at one of the three parking lots
Lenoir Police Department will give out tickets to any vehicles parked along parking lot entrances or on the grass around parking lots
