



### **MANDATORY- Family (participant) PROTOCOLS**

- **Social distancing families-** Each must remain 10' away from anyone that is not their immediate family or household
- **Social distancing players-** players will remain with their family unity. 10' apart while in the dugout areas and at all times unless it is during the game on the field. The dugout area will be marked and designated.
- **Screening-** parents, players, and family members must take their temperature and screen themselves before leaving their house for any Kidball activity.
- **Illness / Symptoms-** parents and players must remain home if they have any illness or symptoms of COVID-19
- **Sanitizer-**players will bring their own hand sanitizer to events.
- **No Longer sharing of equipment-** All players provide their own glove and helmet. We do have bats and balls that can be shared and will be wiped down or players can bring their own. KIDBALL uses **Easton 9-inch Soft stitch Incrediball** should you wish to bring your own ball.
- **Chairs-** Players need to bring their own chairs for dugout extended areas to help with social distancing. They can keep their equipment with their chair.
- **Masks-** are optional both on and off the field
- **Reporting-** A Parent must report any COVID positive player or spectator to KIDBALL within 12 hours of finding out.

### **KIDBALL Protocols**

- **Screening-** KIDBALL Coaches must take their temperature and screen themselves before leaving their house for any Kidball activity.
- **Illness / Symptoms-** KIDBALL Coaches must remain home if they have any illness or symptoms of COVID-19
- **Sanitizer-**KIDBALL Coaches will bring their own hand sanitizer to events.
- **Markings-** mark spacing where players can put bags and spectators can sit
