## MANDATORY- Family (participant) PROTOCOLS

- **Social distancing families-** Each must remain 10' away from anyone that is not their immediate family or household
- **Social distancing players-** players will remain with their family unity. 10' a part while in the dugout areas and at all times unless it is during the game on the field. The dugout area will be marked and designated.
- **Screening-** parents, players, and family members must take their temperature and screen themselves before leaving their house for any Kidball activity.
- **Screening Questionnaire-**Head/Asst Coach or Team Manager must collect initial careening questionnaire from each player and then continue to document through initial and date weekly confirmation of answers to COVID-19 Eligibility of Player Participation screening questions. *Link to document will be provided on website under Helpful Links section.*
- **Illness / Symptoms-** parents and players must remain home if they have any illness or symptoms of COVID-19
- **Sanitizer-**players will bring their own hand sanitizer to events. *A main sanitizing station will also be provided at the field.*
- **Sharing of equipment-** All players provide their own football gloves. KIDBALL will provide initial set of flags to each player. Players are expected to return weekly with their own flags, having sanitized them before return of play.
- **Masks-** Part of the 2020 uniform will be a protective "Performance-activity-mask" given to each player at the start of the season. This mask is always to be worn while on the field of play.
- **Reporting-** A Parent must report any COVID positive player or spectator to KIDBALL within 12 hours of finding out.

## KIDBALL Protocols

- **Screening-** KIDBALL Coaches must take their temperature and screen themselves before leaving their house for any Kidball activity.
- **Illness / Symptoms-** KIDBALL Coaches must remain home if they have any illness or symptoms of COVID-19
- **Sanitizer-**KIDBALL Coaches will bring their own hand sanitizer to events. *A main sanitizing station will also be provided at the field.*
