

Duluth Central Little League



Central Little League serves children living in the Duluth Heights, Central Hillside, Congdon and Park Point neighborhoods (see boundary map on website). Students attending Lowell, Congdon Park, Myers-Wilkins, Holy Rosary, Marshall, Lakeview Christian and Ordean East Middle School are eligible to participate in Central Little League regardless of the location of their primary residence.

DIVISIONS AND FEES

T-BALL (\$50): For kids who have not played any organized baseball. It is suggested new players ages 4 – 6 play at least one year of t-ball. Outs and runs are not recorded and each player gets a chance to hit every inning. Players are encouraged to hit an underhand coach pitched ball or hit from tee. Ten (10) game season beginning early June. Games are typically Tuesdays and Thursdays with occasional practices.

INSTRUCTIONAL MINORS (\$75): For kids with at least one year of playing experience, who can hit an underhand pitch and throw the ball at least 15-feet. Suggested ages 6 – 8 years old. Runs are limited each inning and coaches pitch. Games are typically Mondays and Wednesdays with occasional practices.

MINORS (\$100): For experienced players ages 8 – 11 years old. At this level, players share pitching duties with the coaches. Runs are limited. Games are typically played on Mondays and Wednesdays and players should expect weekly practices.

MAJORS (\$100): For players age 10 – 12. Players who are new to the majors, are required to try out. Players at this level are expected to have a higher level of commitment for all games and practices. Games are player pitch with unlimited runs and typically played on Sundays, Tuesdays and Thursdays. Central teams will play other Central teams as well as Eastern Little League and Lake Park teams.

LATE FEE: A \$20 late fee will be assessed on all registrations received **after March 31st**. REGISTRATION WILL CLOSE ON APRIL 15TH.

SERVICE FEE DEPOSIT: Families are required to perform 6 hours of league volunteer service. A \$100 service fee deposit will be collected prior to players receiving their uniforms. Service fee deposits will be held (checks will not be cashed) until July 31st at which time families that have completed the required service hours will have their checks returned.

FAMILY DISCOUNT: Families with more than 2 players receive a \$50 discount on each additional registration.
