

Sol Soccer Club Player Scholarship Program

Sol Soccer Club is committed to providing a high-quality, affordable youth soccer program, accessible to everyone. While we try hard to keep club fees as low as possible, we realize that paying the full amount can be a hardship for some families. It is important to understand that financial aid is directly dependant on the amount of funds available and the number of applications received. In an effort to fairly distribute what funds we have available, our application is in-depth and requires supporting documentation. No applications cannot be considered without ALL supporting documentation.

Donations from individuals, club fundraising and corporate sponsors allow Sol SC to offer financial scholarships to players with financial needs. A Scholarship Committee is responsible for the review and issuance of scholarships based on a player's financial need and the amount of scholarship funds available.

Please note that the award of a scholarship from Sol Soccer Club for the [*Seasonal Year*] soccer season, August – May, carries with it the obligation to remain on the team the entire year and attend all practices and games.

Financial assistance eligibility:

1. You must be willing to discuss personal financial matters with a member of the scholarship committee.
2. Both parents/guardians, along with the player, agree to actively participate in future team and club fundraisers and contribute volunteer time to Sol SC.
3. Understand, you will be responsible for paying the balance of the player's fees that is not covered by financial assistance. Scholarship application due dates: August 1
