

2021 Season Addendum

Anderson Little League Spring Sandlot Season

SECTION 1 – Purpose

The purpose of the Spring Sandlot Season is to keep players engaged and developing during the COVID-19 pandemic through physical conditioning, skill-building, training and fun.

- a. Practice teams will practice from February 22, 2021 thru the end of May or until Shasta County moves into the Red Tier, whichever comes first.
 - Once Shasta County moves into the Red Tier Anderson Little League will schedule a maximum of 12 games for each team. (Unless interleague play can not be accomplished due to lack of league participation within District 1 or lack of teams within a certain division)
 - If Shasta County does not move into the Red Tier before the end of May then the players will receive a commemorative T-shirt for their participation.
- b. Practice teams will operate following the California State COVID guidance found at www.COVID19.ca.gov

SECTION 2 – Structure

Division structure will follow Article IV, Section 2 of the 2021 Anderson Little League Bylaws.

SECTION 3 – Divisions of play

Practice teams will carry a maximum of 12 players to a roster in all divisions.

- a. Players will be placed on teams in accordance with 2021 Season Addendum, Section 2.
- b. Major Division
 - Placement on a major division practice team does not guarantee that the player will be drafted to the major division once Shasta County moves into the Red Tier.
 - Players will be placed beginning with 12 year olds, then 11 year olds, followed by 10 year olds.
- c. At the time that Shasta County reaches the Red Tier Anderson Little League will schedule try-outs for all players 9-12 years old players who have not met their try-out requirement – both baseball and softball. This includes all players placed on a practice team that have NOT met their try-out

requirement. *Players returning from the 2020 Major division teams to the same division have met their try out requirements for 2021.*

- Players returning to a major team must be registered for the current season to retain their place on their existing team.
- This will be considered to be regular season and teams will be drafted in accordance with Anderson Little League's 2021 Bylaws and the Little League Baseball rule book.
- Players placed on a sandlot team may be drafted to a different team or division.

SECTION 4 – Safety

Anderson Little League will follow all City and State guidance to safely conduct the 2021 Sandlot season.

- a. All players will be required to wear a cloth face covering when social distancing (6 feet) cannot be achieved.
- b. Spectators at practice will be limited to immediate households and will be asked to social distance.

SECTION 5 – Refunds

Refunds will be issued in accordance with Article II, Section 5, point A of the Anderson Little League 2021 bylaws with the following changes to Article II, Section 5, point A, bullet points 1 and 2 (for the 2021 Sandlot Season):

- Cancellation before teams are formed (24 hours prior to the first practice)– registration fee will be refunded in the full amount paid*. (Refund will not include on-line registration fee, late fees or try out fees and will reflect any sibling discounts or early bird discounts that you received)
*this replaces "...before teams are formed (24 hours prior to the first try-out)..."
- Cancellation after teams are formed or within 24 hours prior to the first practice – registration fee will be refunded in the amount paid less a 50% cancellation fee*. (Refund will not include on-line registration fee, late fees or try out fees and will reflect any sibling discounts or early bird discounts that you received)
*this replaces "...after teams are formed or within 24 hours prior to the first practice..."
