# SIMPLIFIED SCORING INSTRUCTIONS

## PLAYER'S FIELDING PERFORMANCE

Inning by inning the scorekeeper will credit the positions shown 1 thru 10 with put-out, assist or errors, noting any fielding changes by filling in the double line separating each inning.



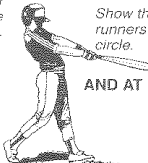
IN THE FIELD

4 The center portion of the square is used by the scorer to show pictorially the type of hit ball, where it was hit, and if it resulted in a put-out, a hit, or a fielding error. The diamond in the center is used by the scorer to follow the progress of the batter/baserunner.

2 The relief pitcher's uniform number is added next to the starting pitcher's number when a pitching change is made in the same inning and a heavy dark line will show the last batter the starting pitcher pitched to.

3 The ball and strike count on the batter is recorded by the scorer. After a pitch is made and the umpire calls the pitch a ball or strike, the scorer places a line through the appropriate box. EXAMPLE: The count on the batter is 1 ball and 2 strikes.

★ Sacrifice Bunt: When the bunted ball advances a runner or runners on base.  
★ Sacrifice Fly: When the fly ball scores the runner from third.

5 The number of the inning a substitute player enters a game is shown in the square marked "S".  
Fill in the top righthand corner to show that the change was made in the top half of the inning.  
Fill in the lower lefthand to show that the change was made in the bottom half of the inning.

The batter is credited with an RBI for each runner that scores by virtue of...  
BB - Base on Balls  
HP - Hit by Pitch  
BK - Balk  
FC - Fielder's Choice  
SF - Sacrifice Fly  
SBT - Sacrifice Bunt  
E - Error: When, in the judgement of the scorer, the runner would have scored if the ball was fielded cleanly.  
Show the total number of runners that scored in a circle.

1 Base on Balls. Batter is awarded first base.

2 Batter hits a double.

3 Batter hits a triple, scoring the two base runners.

4 Batter strikes out. As an out is made in an inning, show a dot in the lower right corner.

5 Batter hits a ground ball to second base. Second baseman fields the ball and throws to first base for the put-out.

Runner advances a base without the aid of a batted ball. Shown by a dark line with the symbol that best describes the reason the runner advances.

SYMBOL  
SB - Stolen Base  
WP - Wild Pitch  
PB - Passed Ball  
E - Error  
BK - Balk
