

HOW TO LINE A FIELD

All lines should be approx 4" wide

Step 1: Lightly water the base lines and home plate area



Step 2: Paint Batters Boxes

We use two types of box frames:



One has a home plate outline. This should be self explanatory.



One has two pegs. These should be lined up to the plate as shown.

Trace the inside of the frame.
Remove frame and paint along the lines.

Step 3: Paint Foul Lines. Either line can be done first.

- Stake down the string in the middle of the foul line in the outfield, approx a foot from the infield
- Run the string past home plate so it is about 2" in from the edge of the plate. Pull tight.
- The foul line should be about $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way from home plate on the front of the batters box. The foul lines should NEVER go to the corner of the batters box!
- Paint lines following the string until you reach the outfield line

Do not paint the outfield lines unless instructed by Officer of the Day or E-Board member
