

RLL Batting Shed Information

In order to make sure everyone has fair and equitable access to the batting shed, the following rules have been established. Any questions, comments, concerns will be directed to the batting shed coordinator, Vice President of Baseball Jim Bussell. Bating shed time slots are 90 minutes long and are as follows

- 8:00-9:30 AM	- 9:30-11:00 AM	-11:00 AM-12:30 PM
-12:30-2:00 PM	-2:00-3:30 PM	-3:30-5:00 PM
-5:00-6:30 PM	-6:30-8:00 PM	

1. Available time slots will be posted on the calendar on the league website. If a coach/manager wishes to have a time slot, he/she must contact the batting shed coordinator no less than 48 hours in advance.
2. If a team cancels or cannot use their scheduled time slot for any reason, notification must be made to the batting shed coordinator as soon as possible.
3. The team occupying the 6:30-8:00 pm time slot is responsible for cleaning up the batting shed (putting nets back to the closed position, emptying any trash, turning the thermostat back down, and shutting off lights).
4. Each team is responsible for making sure that if another team is not present when they complete their time, that the batting shed is clean, lights and thermostat off, and securely locked when they leave.
5. When a team arrives at the shed for their time slot, please do not enter before your scheduled time if another team is practicing before you. Additionally, if your team has a time slot before another team, that team is asked to please exit promptly and avoid "running long".
6. Pee Wee and Bantam teams are allowed to schedule batting shed time as soon as their roster is set. Please keep-in mind, however, that Major and Minors teams are given first choice prior to April 26th as their games start well ahead of younger divisions.
