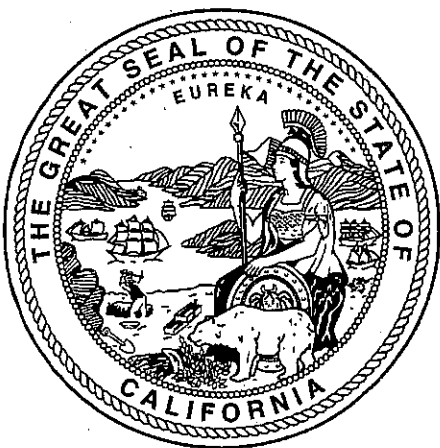



ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

NEWBURY PARK LITTLE LEAGUE

AUG 19 1970

FIRST: The name of this corporation is:

Deputy

NEWBURY PARK LITTLE LEAGUE

SECOND: That the specific and primary purpose for which this corporation is formed is:

(a) To implant firmly in the boys of the community the ideals of good sportsmanship, honesty, loyalty, courage, and reverence, so that they may be well adjusted, stronger and happier boys and will grow to be good, clean, healthy, and trustworthy men.

That the general purposes and powers are:

(b) To take charge of and manage all of the property of said corporation and the affairs thereof.

(c) This corporation shall have and exercise all rights and powers conferred on non-profit corporations under the laws of the State of California, as such laws are now in effect or may at any time hereafter be amended, provided, however, that this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the primary purposes of this corporation.

(d) To engage in such activities as the membership may from time to time direct, provided, however, that such activities may not contravene the foregoing purposes, and provided further that such activities are not for the benefit of any individual or individuals, but are to operate and perpetuate the corporation.

(e) To purchase, lease, hold, sell, develop, mortgage, convey or otherwise acquire or dispose of real and personal property only as the same is necessary or proper for carrying out the purposes of this corporation and to erect such ap-

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1 appropriate buildings or structures as the membership may direct  
2 to so carry out the purposes of this corporation.

3 THIRD: This corporation is organized pursuant to the  
4 General Non-Profit Corporation Law of California.

5 FOURTH: That the term of this corporation shall be  
6 without limitation, but shall be perpetual.

7 FIFTH: The county in this State where the principal  
8 office for the transaction of the business of the corporation is  
9 to be the County of Ventura.

7 SEVENTH: The authorized number and qualifications of  
8 members of the corporation, the different classes of membership,  
9 if any, the property, voting and other rights and privileges of  
10 members and their liability to dues and assessments and the  
11 method of collection thereof, shall be as set forth in the By-Laws.

12 EIGHTH: The Constitution and By-Laws of the corporation  
13 may provide for more than one class of membership and may define  
14 the rights and privileges of members of each class so established,  
15 and may provide for a differentiation of voting rights as between  
16 different classes of membership.

17 NINTH: The property of this corporation is irrevocably  
18 dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income  
19 or assets of this organization shall ever inure to the benefit  
20 of any director, officer or member thereof or to the benefit of  
21 any private persons. Upon the dissolution or winding up of the  
22 corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision  
23 for payment of all debts and liabilities of this corporation,  
24 shall be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation or corpora-  
25 tion which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable  
26 purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under  
27 Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

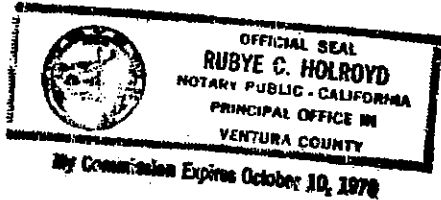
28 If this corporation holds any assets in trust,  
29 or the corporation is formed for charitable purposes, such assets  
30 shall be disposed of in such manner as may be directed by decree  
31 of the Superior Court of the county in which the corporation has  
32 its principal office, upon petition therefor by the Attorney

1 General, or by any person concerned in the liquidation, in a  
2 proceeding to which the Attorney General is a party.

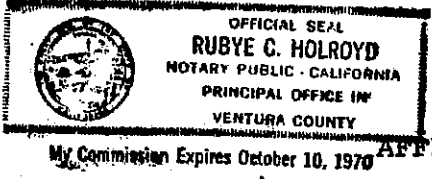




