

## **Guidelines for Attending BCDLS Football Practices, Games & Events**

1. All BCDLS Staff and Volunteer Coaches will be required to wear masks while on the field/in the vicinity of any players, parents, etc.
2. Spectators (parents, grandparents, family members, etc.) are strongly encouraged to wear masks while at the park.
3. Social Distancing Guidelines MUST be followed while attending any BCDLS event (practices, games, evaluations, etc.)
4. A Hand Sanitizing Station will be placed at the entrance of the football complex, please sanitize your hands when arriving and leaving the facility.
5. During practices, parents are encouraged to drop their child off with the coach and remain in the car for the duration of the practice.
6. For games, we are asking the parents to drop their child off with their coach and then remain in their cars until the previous game is over. Once the spectators and teams leave from the previous game, parents may head to the field to set up their chairs.
7. Once parents drop their child off with their coach for their game, coaches and players will head to the Football Practice Field. **NO PARENTS ARE ALLOWED TO BE IN THIS AREA WHILE TEAMS ARE WARMING UP.**
8. Bleachers will be removed from the football field, so we encourage spectators to bring their own chairs.
9. Game times will be spread out as much as possible to allow spectators and teams time to pack up and leave and new teams to come in and set up.
10. Wash hands frequently and cover your nose/mouth when coughing, sneezing, etc.
11. If you or anybody in your household is not feeling well or you are experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19, we ask that you do NOT come to the park. Please stay home.

Safety of our players, volunteers and staff members is our number one priority. With your help and cooperation, we will be able to make this Fall season a great success!
