Guidelines for Attending BCDLS Soccer Practices, Games & Events

- 1. All BCDLS Staff and Volunteer Coaches will be required to wear masks while on the field/in the vicinity of any players, parents, etc.
- 2. Spectators (parents, grandparents, family members, etc.) are strongly encouraged to wear masks while at the park.
- 3. Social Distancing Guidelines MUST be followed while attending any BCDLS event (practices, games, evaluations, etc.)
- 4. A Hand Sanitizing Station will be placed at the entrance of the soccer complex, please sanitize your hands when arriving and leaving the facility.
- 5. During practices and evaluations, parents are encouraged to drop their child off with the coach and remain in the car for the duration of the practice.
- 6. Game times will be spread out as much as possible. When arriving for games, please do not crowd the field that you are playing on. If the previous teams are still there, wait to the side or in the car until they leave. When finishing a game, please try to pack up and leave as soon as possible.
- 7. Wash hands frequently and cover your nose/mouth when coughing, sneezing, etc.
- 8. If you or anybody in your household is not feeling well or you are experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19, we ask that you do NOT come to the park. Please stay home.
