

Hays Soccer Club Coaching Responsibilities

Coaches are required to actively participate in HSC sponsored coaches training each season. Coaches are encourage to obtain an “E” coaching certificate and when possible, continued training and educational opportunities should be pursued.

Coaches are required to stay in good standings with KSYSA, completing all relevant forms and documents.

Coaches and the Director of Coaching are required to coordinate communication prior to the season beginning, monthly during the season, and participate in a post season meeting. The purpose of these meetings is to enlist support, review team/player development, and discuss any problems.

Coaches are required to conduct player and parent meetings.

Coaches are required to select and mentor qualified parent assistant coaches who will be involved in all functions the team including training, games, and team management.

Coaches are required to conduct training/practice sessions.

Coaches are required to attend league and tournament games. Including travel as needed.

Coaches are required to encourage participation in outside activities, such at Olympic Development Camp (ODP), and development camps.

Coaches are responsible for parents conduct during Hays Soccer Club games and practices.

No outside soccer related positions or activities are permitted unless approved by the Club’s Board. A request must be made to the Board in writing outlining the position and potential conflicts. Failure to do so may result in the disciplinary actions which could include immediate dismissal.
