

**2021 BROADWAY COMMUNITY LITTLE LEAGUE**  
**Broadway Park – Covid Restrictions & Guidelines**

The health and safety of our players, coaches, volunteers, spectators, and fans is of the highest priority to the Broadway Community Little League (BCLL). We hereby submit the following Covid guidelines for games played within the fields located at Broadway Park.

1. Please do not allow your child to play, or you as the parent or guardian attend, a game at Broadway Park if you are not feeling well or have a fever over 100.4. This may include but not limited to a cough, shortness of breath, headaches, blurred vision, stomach aches, etc.
2. All players must use their own equipment including gloves, bats, and helmets.
3. Players must bring their own water/drink to games and practices. Please write your child's name on the drink container to avoid confusion. No snacks will be distributed during practice or games.
4. There will be no handshakes by the teams after the game. A tip of the hat or wave out of respect for your opponent is appropriate.
5. For all events, it is advised that spectators sit along the 1st and 3rd base foul lines or around the outfield fence using their own seats, not directly behind home plate. That area will be used by coaches and players for equipment and/or personnel overflow. Bleachers will remain at the ballpark but social distancing will need to be followed. This means seating in every other row (1st, 3rd, 5th) and 6' apart. Please only sit with those in your immediate family.
6. The consumption of any food including sunflower seeds and gum in the dugout is prohibited.
7. Each team is provided with practice and game balls. Each team must use their own game ball when on defense, and the opposition will bring out their game ball when they take the field. Please take your ball back to the dugout with you each time, do not intermingle balls.
8. In the event you or your child gets a confirmed positive COVID-19 test, or has been exposed to someone that has had a confirmed test, please contact your head coach/manager. The manager will then contact the Safety Office and/or League Vice President to discuss appropriate next steps with the entire BCLL Board that are in line with the current guidance from the Virginia Department of Health.
9. We ask that all spectators adhere to 6 feet social distancing guidelines while attending the game(s). Please take extra considerations if you are in the proximity of an 'at-risk' individual.
10. BCLL will provide sanitizing materials for each dugout where coaches will use after every game, prior to another team entering that dugout for a practice or game.
11. Players and coaches will not be required to wear a mask at all times, but will have the option to do so if they choose. Coaches should have a mask on when they cannot maintain 6' of social distancing. Examples include but not limited to home plate meetings with the umpire before a game, mound visits with a pitcher, working on individual skills development during practices, etc.
12. While volunteering in the concession stand, volunteers will need to wear a mask.

Broadway Community Little League reserves the right to change or amend these guidelines should federal/state or local guidelines change. We ask for your patience and understanding as we work through these guidelines to ensure our children have an opportunity to play.
