- 1.) Background Check – Valid for 2 years**
- 2.) Concussion Training – Valid for 3 years**

COACHES AND OFFICIALS CONCUSSION TRAINING

**Effective March 2013, Concussion Training is state mandated and required for all
volunteer coaches and officials.**

- Youth sports coaches and officials must present evidence that they have completed the online training modules provided by the Ohio Department of Health.
- All CWJRD coaches and officials are required to go to:

This free on-line course is available through the NFHS. Follow these steps to complete the course:

Click on the button that says, “*Register.*” In the window that appears, complete “*Account Setup.*”

- 1.) When your registration is complete you may “*order*” the free “*Concussion in Sports*” course. Continue following prompts. Although it may look like you’ll be charged for the course, there is no cost.
- 2.) Once you have completed “*checkout*”, you’ll be able to take the free online course.
- 3.) When you have completed and passed the course, you have the option of printing a certificate of completion.
- 4.) Completed certificates must be emailed to cebert@cwrecreation.com

This course is FREE and the certificate is valid for 3 years.

- If you coach at a middle school or high school and already have a valid Pupil Activity Permit / Validation from your Ohio Department of Education (ODE) – this satisfies the above requirement as this permit is also valid for 3 years.
