## COVID-19 GUIDELINES FOR NORTHMONT WEE BOLTS HOME GAMES

**Location:** Randolph Stadium - 515 N. Main St., Englewood, OH 45322

### OVERALL

- Game schedules/slots will be at least 1 hour and 45 minutes (typically 1.5 hours) to allow for additional sanitizing between games.
  - All surfaces that are touched will be cleaned, including but not limited to: game balls, down and distance markers, press box, concessions, bleachers, restrooms, etc.
  - Hand sanitizer will be available at convenient locations throughout the facility.
- The spectator allowance inside Randolph Stadium is **350**.
  - This number does not include Players, Cheerleaders, Coaches, Site Volunteers, or those age 6 and under (accompanied by a parent).
  - This will be tracked at the entrance gate, by roster, with a number of 4 spectators per participating athlete.
  - The maximum capacity will fluctuate by the support of volunteers.

- Pathways will be marked for social distancing (i.e., one-way foot traffic flow, seating in stands, etc.)
- The Wee Bolts will follow all recommendations for the venue provided by the most recent copy of the Ohio Director's Order, the OHSAA, and Northmont City Schools.
- All participants and spectators must not exhibit signs or symptoms of COVID-19 upon entering Randolph Stadium.
- Spectators must wear face coverings at all times unless they are medically exempt per CDC guidelines.
- Spectators will scan 1 QR Code (located within this document and outside the entrance to Randolph Stadium) per household upon entering Randolph Stadium.
- Family and household members should sit together and be socially distanced from other individuals/family/household groups.
  - Six feet social distancing must be maintained throughout Randolph Stadium even when not sitting in the home side fixed bleachers.
  - Due to limited seating in the home bleachers, ALL spectators (home and visitor) should plan to bring personal seating arrangements (chair, blanket, etc.).
  - There will be no fixed bleachers on the visitors side of the stadium. ALL visiting teams should inform their spectators to bring personal seating arrangements.
- Parents/Families/Guardians will not be permitted to enter Randolph Stadium until all spectators from the previous game have exited Randolph Stadium.
- Spectators planning to re-enter the stadium for an additional game must exit and re-enter through the ticket booth to help control the number of spectators inside the stadium.
- Anyone with COVID-19 symptoms should not enter Randolph Stadium.
- Signage will be placed throughout Randolph Stadium as a reminder on ways to stop the spread of COVID-19.

### Payment Options

- In an effort to help prevent the spread of COVID-19, the Northmont Wee Bolts will be accepting credit/debit cards for the 2020 season at the entrance as well as the concession stand. While we prefer you pay with a credit/debit card, we will be accepting cash.

## **Football Player Check In**

- ALL football players (home and visitors) should check in at the Player Check In table located inside the stadium to the left of the ticket booth.
- Each team should have one member of their coaching staff present at the Player Check In table until both teams are fully checked in.
- A player temperature column has been added to the Mandatory Play Form and must be supplied by each team so temperatures may be recorded at the Player Check In table prior to players warming up.
- If a player has a temperature of 100.4 or higher, they will be moved aside (preferably to a shaded area) to cool off for 5 minutes. If they are 100.4 or higher during the second temperature check, they will not be permitted to play.
- If a player fails to check in, they will not be permitted to play.
- Parents/Families/Guardians will not enter the field until all spectators from the previous game have exited Randolph Stadium.
- Randolph Stadium must be cleared of spectators following each game.
  - If you are planning to re-enter the stadium, you must exit and re-enter through the ticket booth to help control the number of spectators inside the stadium.
- Each athlete must have their own water bottle and remain socially distanced on the sideline.

## **Pre-Game**

- Players, coaches, officials, and staff are not to physically contact each other before or after games (i.e., greetings, team huddles, high-fives, etc.).

## **Coin Toss**

- Limit attendees to the referee, umpire and one designated representative from each team while maintaining social distancing of 6 feet.
- No handshakes are to take place before or after the coin toss.

## **During Game**

- Coaches / Players should designate an area for each player on the sideline where they may keep their water bottle, towel, mask, etc. Players should remain at their designated area unless they are in the game. Social distancing of 6 feet should be maintained on each sideline.
- One timeout per half will be extended to two minutes.
- Players should sanitize their hands during timeouts and maintain social distancing.

## **Halftime**

- Halftime will be 8 minutes in length.

## Cheer

- Wee Bolt cheerleaders should complete their normal daily self-assessment prior to entering Randolph Stadium.
- Visitor cheerleaders should follow their organization's daily self-assessment guidelines prior to entering Randolph Stadium.
- If a cheerleader has a temperature of 100.4 or higher, they shall cool off (preferably in a shaded area) for 5 minutes. If they are 100.4 or higher during the second temperature check, they will not be permitted to participate.
- There will be no hello cheer between squads for the 2020 season.
- Cheerleaders will remain behind each end zone and maintain social distancing of 6 feet as much as possible. Cheerleaders may utilize the field of play (inside the 20-yard line) during timeouts provided the ball is not spotted within the 20-yard line at their specific end zone.
- Cheerleaders should be ready to take the field as soon as halftime begins.

## Post-Game

- There will be no post game handshake. Instead, opposing teams should interact socially distant from each other in a non-contact way (wave, clap, salute, etc.).
- Each team may meet on the field while following social distancing protocols for team instructions. Teams should then immediately exit the stadium following each game. There is to be no congregating of coaches, players, staff, spectators, officials, or site volunteers.
- The Mandatory Play Form must be turned into the concession stand following each game.

## Volunteers

- All volunteers should follow CDC and social distancing guidelines, including wearing a mask.

## Press Box

- The press box will be limited to a capacity of 2 individuals. Intro/Halftime Music and Rosters should be given to the Player Check In Table. A Wee Bolts Board Member will deliver to the Press Box. Items may be retrieved from the Player Check In Table following each game as well.

## Concession Stand

- Anyone in the concession stand should wear a mask and gloves.
- Spectators are expected to follow a 6-foot social distance while waiting in line at the concession stand.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at the concession stand.

A limited menu will be available.
