Challenger baseball provides a safe environment for kids to "get off the bench and play", instilling self esteem and allowing kids to gain self confidence. We will implement a "buddy" system, the SYC Little League teams will provide players from their teams to assist challenger players in the field when necessary.

Challenger baseball stresses participation not competition. Every player gets to bat, field, and run the bases. There are no outs and balls and strikes are not counted. Victories are won with achievement and involvement in the greatest game ever played.
