

# Los Alamos Little League Baseball

## *Divisions of Baseball*

### TEE BALL-BOYS

- For players ages 4-7
- Instructional program focused on fun, fitness and fundamentals.
- Players either hit off a tee or are pitched to by a coach.
- May be played on a 50' or 60' diamond

### SENIORS BASEBALL

- For players ages 13-16
- Uses a conventional 90-foot diamond with a pitching distance of 60 feet, 6 inches. Modified diamond dimensions may be used during the regular season.

### MINOR LEAGUE

- For players ages 7-11  
(6 year olds may play provided they have 1 year of Tee Ball experience)
- Instructional program that builds on the fundamentals learned in Tee Ball
- Broken into two sub-divisions, "Minors B" which consists of "coach or machine pitch" in order to transition they children from Tee Ball to hitting a controlled moving ball. For children with a little more developed playing skills that would like to transition to a "player pitched" ball, we offer "Minors A".
- In general, Minors A allows players an opportunity to gain more experience before advancing to the Little League Division (ages 9-12).
- Played on a 60' diamond with 46' pitching distance
- Tournament opportunities for players 9-11

### LITTLE LEAGUE (MAJORS)

- For players ages 9-12
- A league may limit this division to 10-12 year old players or 11-12 year olds
- 12-year olds may play in both the Major and Junior Division or Senior Division with an approved waiver
- Players from the Major Division may qualify for a league's 11-12 year old tournament team that has an opportunity to advance to the Little League World Series in South Williamsport
- Played on a 60' diamond with a 46' pitching distance
