ISFC 2010, 2011 TEAMS (U10):

- Focus on the development of players and individual skills
- Practices 2 times per week
- 8-10 ISL/EASA league games and friendlies (Jasper, Washington and Evansville)
- 1-2 local travel soccer tournament (Owensboro or Evansville)
- ISFC player fees:
 - \$100-\$200 club fee (registration fees apply toward club fee)
 - o \$70-\$100 team fees for the season
 - o Personal equipment, travel costs and meals are each family's responsibility
 - o \$125 uniform fee (new players only, estimated)

ISFC 2009, 2008 TEAMS (U11, U12):

- Focus on the development of players and individual skills
- Practices 2 times per week
- 8-10 ISL/EASA league games (Jasper, Washington and Evansville)
- 2 local travel soccer tournament (Owensboro or Evansville)
- Option for 1 out of town travel soccer tournament
- ISFC player fees:
 - \$155-\$425 club fee (registration fees apply toward club fee)
 - \$100+ team fees for the season
 - Personal equipment, travel costs and meals are each family's responsibility
 - \$125 uniform fee (new players only, estimated)

ISFC 2007, 2006, 2005 TEAMS (U13, U14, U15):

- Focus on the development of team play, competitive play, continued player development
- Practices 2 3 times per week
- 8-10 ISL league games (southern Indiana)
- 1-2 local travel soccer tournaments (southern Indiana, northern Kentucky)
- At least 1 out of town travel soccer tournament
- ISFC player fees:
 - o \$155-\$510 club fee (registration fees apply toward club fee)
 - o \$125+ team fees for the season
 - o Personal equipment, travel costs and meals are each family's responsibility
 - \$125 uniform fee (new players only, estimated)

ISFC 2004, 2003, 2002, 2001 TEAMS (U16, U17, U18, U19):

- Focus on the development of team play, competitive play, continued player development
- Practices 2 3 times per week
- 8-10 ISL league games (Indiana locations based on ISL division/play group)
- 1-2 local travel soccer tournaments (southern Indiana, northern Kentucky)
- At least 1 out of town travel soccer tournament
- At least 1 college showcase tournament (U16, U17, U18, U19)
- ISFC player fees:
 - \$160-\$525 club fee (registration fees apply toward club fee)
 - o \$140+ team fees for the season
 - o Personal equipment, travel costs and meals are each family's responsibility
 - \$125 uniform fee (new players only, estimated)
- Indoor conditioning varies by team
- Outdoor practices begin in early mid March for all teams (2-3 days per week)
- The Indiana Soccer League season begins March 23, 2020 and ends June 2, 2020 (expect to have games and tournaments between those dates) All players are required to attend games <u>and</u> tournaments scheduled by their teams
- ➤ Player payments/fees will be collected in three equal payments (December 2019, January and February 2020)
- > Team meetings will be held in early December
