Activation of EMS

1. If EMT's are at the event, then a signal (discussed in advance) should be given to summon them forward.
2. If EMT's are not on site, call Acadian Ambulance at 800.259.1111. The following information should be provided to the dispatcher:
 - a. Identify yourself and give campus location of injured athlete (specific directions listed above)
 - b. Inform dispatcher that a member of the EAP team will be waiting at the athletic site entrance
 - c. The condition of the athlete(s) and number of injured athletes if more than one
 - d. Inform them of the suspected injury and the care currently being provided
 - e. Ask if any additional information is needed
 - f. Make sure that you hang up only after the dispatcher has hung up

Original Emergency Contact Form/Medical File Location

Original LYSA Athlete Medical Files are stored with Association Director. Visiting Team Coaches encouraged to travel and keep their athlete medical and emergency contact information with them
