Coach, Parent, and Spectator Code of Conduct

We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behavior for the young players that play in Eastside FC programs. Parents have a tremendous influence on children's enjoyment and success on the soccer field. Parents, coaches, spectators and club officials have a responsibility to provide an environment where players can have fun while developing skills and an enthusiasm for the game.

Play your part in supporting your child's development by observing the following Code of Conduct:

I agree to:

- Remember that children play for FUN
- Applaud effort and good play
- Encourage your child and others. Praise effort and performance, not results
- Remain outside the field of play, in the designated spectator area during games
- Refrain from coaching players during games or practices; let the coaches do their job
- Always respect the match officials' decisions
- Refrain from officiating the game from the sideline; let the officials do their job
- Encourage players and other spectators to respect the opposition and officials
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting or abusive language or behavior
- Support coaching decisions; discuss any concerns directly with the coach at an appropriate time/place (e.g. not at the game or practice field in front of children)

I understand entering the field of play, failure to respect match official decisions or engaging in offensive, insulting or abusive language or behavior will result in action being taken by Eastside FC which could include suspension or expulsion from club activities.
