

MYA Board Meeting - 5/25/16

Steve Young opened the meeting with a prayer

Board Changes:

- Steve Young announced that Donnie Robinson had requested to be moved to an advisor role on the board of directors, which opened up an additional spot on the board
- Steve nominated Chris Harbinson to be added to the board. It was seconded and no one opposed
- Steve then announced that he was going to have to step back from his position as President of MYA
- The board then nominated Chris Harbinson to assume the role as President. The nomination was seconded and approved

OTAs and Skills Assessments

- It was decided that the June 12th OTA would be held at Mooresville Middle School
 - Steve Young volunteered to check to make sure that there was no American Legion game on that day and he would check if our cheer OTA could use the gym
- It was decided that our first skills assessment day would be held on July 10th at MHS. Brian Elkin will work with Champions to coordinate the skills assessment for that date

 - We will ask Jeff Heal to help with skills assessment on 7/17

Equipment Update

- Uniform/equipment fittings and distribution are tentatively scheduled for July 23. A schedule will be sent out informing each team when they should arrive at the storage facility. The players will try on helmet, shoulder pads and pants and take them home with them
- It was decided that we will order black socks only
- A decision will be made at the June board meeting on what MYA wants to do for breast cancer awareness month

Bi-laws changes/draft process

- There will be a meeting following the June 12th OTA with head coaches, director of football and available board members to discuss bi-laws changes needed to address the draft process
- The bi-laws changes will need to be presented at the June board meeting and voted on at the July board meeting

Scholarships/Hardships

- The families that are approved for scholarships will need to visit Mrs Debbie Wyatt at the recreation department and register in person

- MYA will need to notify Mrs Debbie that these families are approved

Camp advertising:

- It was decided that MYA will advertise 3rd party camps on a case by case basis
- As of now, we agree to advertise the MHS cheer camp, Scott Montgomery's camp and the Champions Camp
