

Tournament Check-In Procedures

Updated 8/30/2018

All teams are required to check-in at the HQ Tent prior to their first game on Saturday.
(There is no Friday night check-in)



Teams with 8:00 am games must check in starting at 7:15 am
Teams with 9:00 am games must check in starting at 8:00 am
All other teams must check in 90 minutes before their first game.

At CHECK-IN:

1. **ROSTER** – You must provide a copy of your US Youth Soccer/Bonzi roster, which we will keep. (Write in any Guest Players, and cross off any players not attending.)
2. **PLAYER PASSES** – You must be prepared to show us Player Passes for all players/guests. Referees may ask to hold your player passes during games.
3. **MEDICAL RELEASES** – You must be prepared to show us Medical Releases for all players/guests
4. **WAIVER** – You will be required to sign a waiver. It will be preprinted with your team information. The Waiver states you will have both Player Passes and Medical Release forms with you during all games, and understanding of the rules.

GAME TIMES – All Games will start on the hour, each hour! If you or your opponent are not ready, the Referees will still start the game clock. Each game will end no later than 5 minutes before each Hour. Have your players at the field 30 minutes before each game.

RULES – Please make sure you read the rules. If you RUN UP the score or get a red card, you will lose points, read the rules.

PATCH EXCHANGE – Exchange of Club Patches after every game is highly encouraged.

SPORTSMANSHIP – We expect the highest level of sportsmanship to be displayed by all participants. To emphasize this goal, each team will receive 4 Fall Classic Sportsmanship Awards. At the end of each game you, the coach, should give this award to one player on YOUR team that showed the best sportsmanship.

These awards will not necessarily to be given to the best player on the team. Kids learn the basics of sportsmanship from the adults in their lives, especially their parents and their coaches. Kids who see adults behaving in a sportsmanlike way gradually come to

understand that the real winners in sports are those who know how to persevere and to behave with dignity - whether they win or lose a game.

We expect the coaches and parents to be role models for the players. Please share this with your parents. Team's, Coaches, Parents that do not show proper sportsmanship will not be allowed to return to the tournament in the future.

OTHER AWARDS

- U8 through U10 Teams will receive participation medals (provided at Check-In).
- U11-U17 divisions will play for First and Second place awards. Third place awards will be given in divisions with 7+ teams.

NO SMOKING – This tournament is held on Middlesex County Park property (Green Acres). No Smoking is allowed anywhere.
